Steve Moss has worked for 30 years in disability research, initially in the field of visual impairment, and subsequently in the area of intellectual disability. He developed an international reputation for his work in the fields of ageing and of mental health. His work on development of the PAS-ADD system (Psychiatric Assessment Schedules for Adults with Developmental Disabilities) is particularly well known, and these assessments are now used in many countries throughout the world. He is currently an Honorary Senior Lecturer at the Institute of Psychiatry, King's College London.
